What You Need

- White or black paper
- Newspaper
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Markers or felt tip pens

- Gather all the materials you need for this activity.
- Draw the shapes you see here onto your sheet of newspaper using a black marker. There are ears, head, tear-drop shaped body, tail and 2 semi-circle paws to draw.






• Now cut each shape out carefully. Your collage cat is ready for assembly!





- Assemble the shapes to resemble the example below: head and ears on top of the body and the paws and tail in the right position too.
- Using your glue stick, now firmly stick each individual shape into place. Your cat will really start taking shape now!







- Next job is to give your cat some eyes, a nose and whiskers.
- I cut out two oval eyes and a triangular nose.
- I cut some long strips of newspaper for his whiskers. I coloured all the pieces using a marker and attached each piece to my cat using my glue stick.





Now your cat is looking good and ready to go!

 You can use this technique to create lots of different fun and interesting art. Look at the shark I made!
